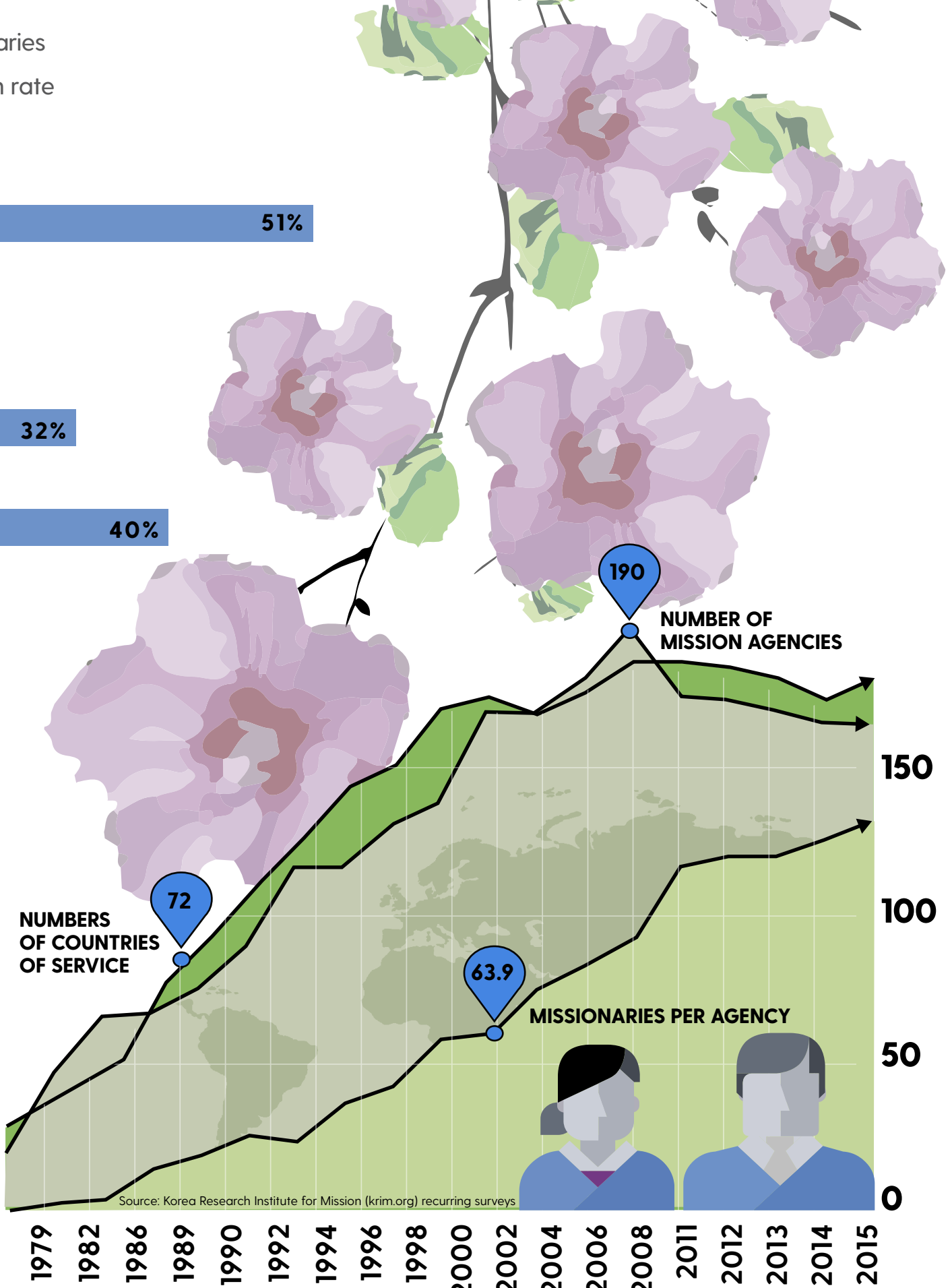
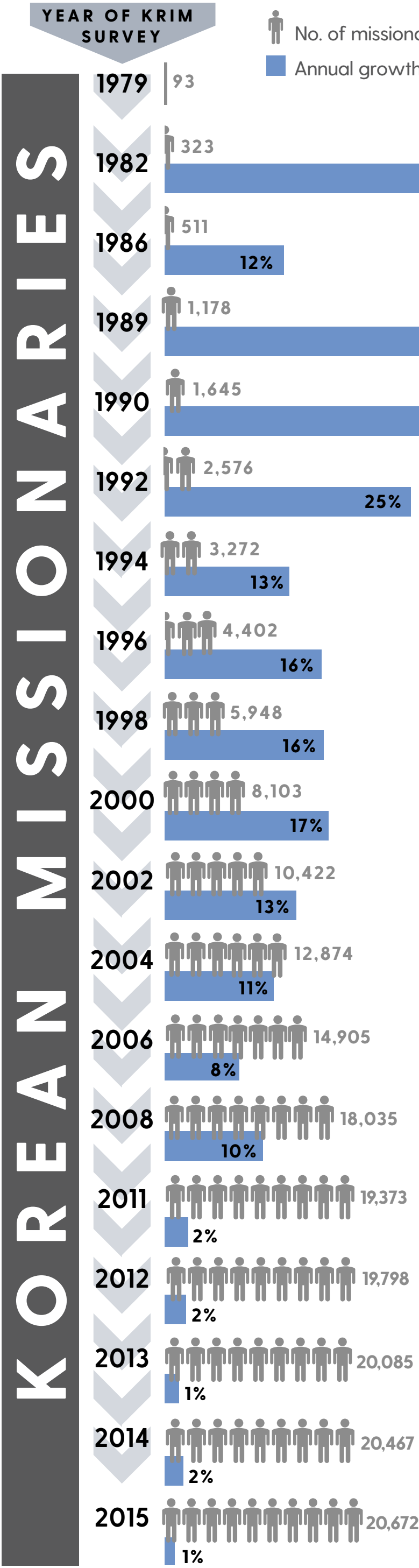


# THE BLOSSOMING OF THE KOREAN MISSION MOVEMENT
